Purpose:	To provide an update to Trustees regarding the 2019/20 Facility Collaboration and Co-Build Opportunities meetings.
Content:	Background
Financial Implications:	On an annual basis and in accordance with Procedure 4015b, Community Planning and Facility Collaboration Opportunities (CPFCO), Thames Valley District School Board hosts CPFCO meetings where community organization representatives and municipal partners are invited to learn and discuss potential collaboration and co-build opportunities at listed school facilities. In light of the current provincial state of emergency and staff resource limitations, the CPFCO meetings will be deferred from June 2020 until early Fall 2020. This deferral enables TVDSB to fulfill the intent of the requirement to host the annual CPFCO meetings, acknowledging the unprecedented situation and the challenges of hosting a meeting prior to the end of the 2019/20 school year. Schools available for facility collaboration arrangements and information on potential co-build opportunities has been updated on the TVDSB website.
