 - c. Become the Best Place to Work, Learn, and Grow

- 5. **Alignment with Ministry of Education Student Achievement Plan:** The budget reflects and supports the Student Achievement Plan:
 - a. Achievement of learning outcomes in core academic skills
 - b. Preparation of students for future success
 - c. Student engagement and well-being
