	Superintendent Lynd and Manager Macey presented the Revised Estimates for 2024-25 for feedback and input, noting the projected deficit for compliance purposes and the cost saving measures implemented.
	Questions of clarification were addressed by Administration regarding the feedback and input requested from the Trustees, the cost related to the Robotics Program, and the musical instrument budget for new schools.
	Trustees against the motion argued that the removal of band instruments in grades 7 and 8 could set a precedent.
	Trustees in favour of the motion argued that Trustees cannot value one music program over another.

	THAT funding in the amount of \$43,800 be allocated to the guitar program at the three new Thames Valley District School Board schools.

responsibilities of the TVDSB in the Memo of
Understanding (MOU) with the City of London and the
London Transit Commission were highlighted.

Questions of clarification were addressed by Administration regarding staff resources available to meet the criteria set out in the MOU, the potential impact of the TVDBS's role in the MOU on existing priorities such as the TVDSB's Multi-Year Strategic Plan, and timelines.

It was decided that Administration would report to the Trustees at the January Board meeting on work that would need to be re-prioritized if the TVDSB committed to the MOU.
