Purpose	Establish a clear link from the report itself and the committee's mandate/purpose/goals:
Content:	The committee completed the following actions to work towards fulfilling its mandate: Everyone Belongs District Results Interim Associate Director Wilkinson and Manager Stager provided a PowerPoint presentation for information on the 2024 Everyone Belongs Survey District Results focusing on collecting identity data, the Thames Valley District School Board (TVDSB) Multi-Year Strategic Plan: Strategic Direction #2, the development of the survey and results, the strategies for survey support for students, parents, caregivers, and staff, the guiding principles for collecting, analyzing, and reporting identity data, and next steps. It was noted that information regarding staff initiatives to lessen the Not at All or To Some Extent response options on the survey

would be provided at a future Program and School Services Advisory Committee (PASSA) Meeting.

Student Attendance Presentation

Superintendent Bruce and Manager Lambert provided an update through a PowerPoint presentation on system initiatives that have been implemented to improve student attendance rates. It was noted that as part of the Better Schools and Student Outcomes Act, the TVDSB is required to share attendance data with the Ministry of Education as part of the Student Achievement Plan.

School Climate Surveys, 2024-2025

Manager Stager and Associate Wood provided a PowerPoint presentation for information on the 2024-2025 School Climate Surveys.

Highlights of the presentation included key information.

It was noted that Trustees can reach out to the school Superintendent regarding the Safe and Inclusive School Plans in their area.

Differentiated Supports for Schools Discussion

Interim Associate Director Wilkinson led a conversation with the committee and Superintendents regarding differentiated supports and allocation to schools.

It was noted that TVDSB has moved away from a blanket designation characterizing a school as in need of supports. The work has become more specific, targeted and based on data that assists in differentiating the TVDSB's approach to providing supports for schools. Schools may receive additional targeted supports through initiatives and guidelines provided by the Ministry of Education, district-level decisions, and/or identification of individual school needs. Allocations are designed to respond to the unique needs of both students and schools, ensuring a more balanced and effective distribution of resources.

It was noted that information regarding Ministry funding will be provided to Trustees as it becomes available.
